The Musconetcong Sewerage Authority proposes a budget totaling \$4,489,099 for fiscal year 2018 compared to the \$4,494,219.00 budgeted for fiscal year 2017. The major decrease is for interest payments on debt and the significant increase is for maintenance, repairs and equipment expenses due to the aging of the sewer plant.

2. Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on Anticipated Revenues, especially service charges and on the general purpose/component unit financial statements. Explain significant increases or decreases, if any. Revenues to support the budget are derived from user charges apportioned among the seven participating municipalities using the system. Operating and Maintenance costs are based on metered flow with a guaranteed minimum provision. Debt Service costs are based on the plant's capacity allocated to the participating municipalities. The use of Unrestricted Net Position has decreased from \$107,000 in 2017 to \$101,880 in 2018.

3. Describe the state of the local/regional economy and how it may impact the proposed Annual Budget, including the planned Capital Budget/Program.

The state of the local economy has no affect on the budgets of the Authority because all revenues are derived from the service contracts with the participating municipalities.

Compensation includes payments and other benefits provided to both employees and independent contractors in exchange for services.
- Reportable compensation: The aggregate compensation that is reported (or is required to be reported) on Form W-2, box 1 or 5, whichever amount is greater, and/or Form 1099-MISC, box 7, for the most recent calendar year ended 60 days before the start of the proposed budget year. For example, for fiscal years ending December 31, 2018, the calendar year 2016 W-2 and 1099 should be used (60 days prior to start of budget year is November 1, 2017, with 2015 being the most recent calendar year ended), and for fiscal years ending June 30, 2019, the calendar year 2017 W-2 and 1099 should be used (60 days prior to start of budget year is May 1, 2018, with 2017 being the most recent calendar year ended).
- Other Public Entity: Any municipality, county, local authority, fire district, or other government unit, regardless of whether it is related in any way to the Authority either by function or by physical location.
