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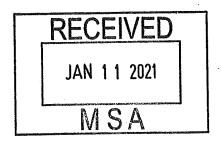

THE LOCAL/REGIONAL ECONOMY HAS BEEN STEADILY IMPROVING IN THE AREAS SERVICED BY THE AUTHORITY. THE MUSCONETCONG SEWERAGE AUTHORITY HAS CONSIDERED THIS FACTOR WHILE PREPARING THE 2021 BUDGET.
